

Bee Orchid









Ophrys apifera Huds.





DESCRIPTION

A perennial herbaceous plant with an insect - like labellum, ovate-lanceolate leaves, three purple sepals

HABITAT

Semi - dry turf, on limestone, in grassland, in woodland, calcipholous

DISTRIBUTION

From Portugal to the Caucasus, common in the Mediterranean region





DANGER

Inappropriate maintenance (mowing of roadsides during the growing season, mowing before seeding), Habitat destruction (construction activity), Inappropriate management (intensive grazing between May and July, grazing of small deposits).
