

Frivald's frog orchid

Gymnadenia frivaldii Griseb.

DESCRIPTION

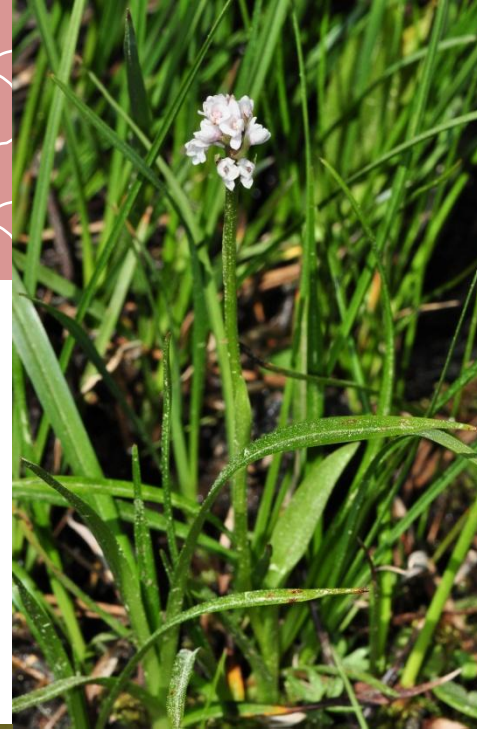
Slender plant, up to 30 cm high, with a dense inflorescence of numerous, small, pinkish-white flowers.

HABITAT

Wet meadows and bogs, on siliceous substrates.

DISTRIBUTION

Endemic to the Balkan Peninsula, from southern Carpathians to northern Greece.



DANGER

Residential & commercial development (tourism & recreation areas), agriculture (livestock farming & ranching), human intrusions & disturbance (recreational activities), natural ecosystem modifications.
